

Poster Presentation Guidelines

1. Overview

Posters are individual, free-standing research presentations. They are an appropriate format when research findings can be explained concisely, are suited for graphic or visual presentation, and/or when the presenter would benefit from a high level of interaction and discussion with attendees.

All accepted posters will be presented in person during designated poster sessions at the conference. Each presenter will receive their assigned session schedule via email.

2. Language

The official language of ISSBD 2026 is English. All poster materials and presentations must be prepared and delivered in English.

3. Poster Sessions

A total of seven poster sessions will be held during the conference. All presenters will be notified of their allocated session by email.

- Venue: Premier Ballroom C, Songdo Convensia (2F)

Information on poster mounting and removal times, as well as assigned board numbers, will be provided later, together with your session details.

The Local Organizing Committee will provide poster display boards and double-sided adhesive tape for mounting. Please note that no audio-visual equipment will be available for poster presentations.

4. Poster Size

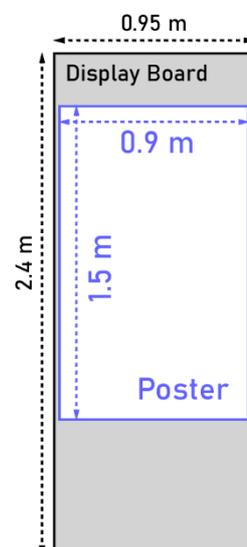
The display board size is 2.4 m (height) x 0.95 m (width).

The recommended poster size is **1.5 m (height) x 0.9 m (width)**.

All poster materials must fit within the allocated board area.

5. Poster Contents

Each poster must include the following information:



- Title of presentation
- Author name(s)
- Institutional affiliation(s)
- Country(ies)

The poster title must be **identical to the title submitted in the abstract**.

Presenters are responsible for mounting and removing their own posters. The organizers are not responsible for any loss or damage. Posters that are not removed by the designated removal time will be automatically disposed of.

All posters must be printed and brought by the presenters. ISSBD 2026 will not print posters or accept poster files via email.

6. Registration

All presenters must complete their conference registration, including payment, by March 25, 2026, for their poster to be included in the final program.
