

## Poster Presentation Guidelines

### 1. Overview

Posters are individual, free-standing research presentations designed for concise and impactful communication. This format is ideal for findings that benefit from graphic or visual representation and for presenters seeking high-level interaction and in-depth discussion with attendees.

### 2. Language

All poster materials and presentations must be prepared and delivered in English.

### 3. Poster Sessions

A total of eight poster sessions will be held during the conference.

### 4. Poster Size

The total size of the display board is 2.4 m (height) x 0.95 m (width).

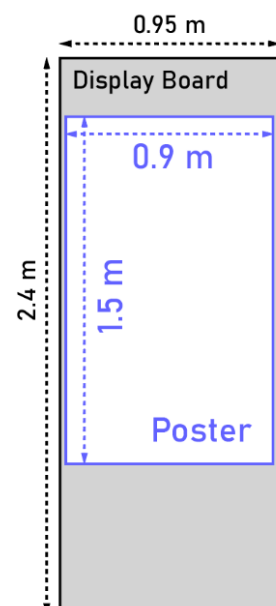
The recommended poster size is **1.5 m (height) x 0.9 m (width)**.

All poster materials must fit within the allocated board area.

### 5. Poster Presentation Instructions

**Finding Your Board:** Each presenter is assigned a unique Poster Number that indicates both the poster session and display board location.

- *Example:* **PS1\_001** refers to **Poster Session 1**, and assigned Board Number **001**.



**Materials Provided:** A display board and double-sided adhesive tape will be provided on-site. A board number will be pre-attached to the top corner of the board.

**Presenter Responsibility:** Presenters are expected to stay by their posters during their designated presentation time to engage with attendees and answer questions.

- **Mounting & Removal:** Presenters are responsible for mounting and removing their own posters. Please note that any posters remaining after the removal deadline will be disposed of.
- **Liability:** The organizers are not responsible for any loss or damage to posters.

**Equipment:** Please note that NO audio-visual equipment or power outlets will be available for poster presentations.

**Printing & Shipping:** All posters must be printed and brought to the venue by the presenters.

- The Secretariat will not provide on-site printing services, store posters shipped in advance, or accept digital poster files via email.

## 6. Poster Contents

Each poster must include the following information:

- Title of presentation
- Author name(s)
- Institutional affiliation(s)
- Country(ies)

The poster title must be **identical to the title submitted in the abstract**.
